VETERAN HORSE SOCIETY



Golden Ticket qualifiers (in hand and/or ridden) are offered to specially selected breed and specialist Championship Shows at the discretion of the VHS. All Golden Ticket qualifying shows will be listed on the VHS website.

1. Supreme Final qualification – as advertised in the qualifying schedule, champion and/or reserve champion will each qualify for the VHS Supreme Final and be awarded a golden ticket qualification card. This card must be completed and submitted to Head Office, together with a membership and showing card application and fee. A signed showing card will then be sent out with the membership pack, allowing entry to the Supreme Final.
2. Entry into to the relevant age category of the Supreme Final (in hand or ridden, as qualified), **must be made within 21 days of the qualifying show date** (non-members will need to become full members to do so). Late entries will not be accepted. If a competitor has already qualified or does not wish to attend, they must refuse the qualification and pass it down the line **on the day** to a maximum of 4th place.
3. For turnout and tack rules at the Supreme Final please refer to the Show Schedule.
4. Competitors must ensure they comply with all VHS rules before entering the Supreme Final, this includes amateur status, see rule C11.
5. Should a VHS Golden Ticket qualification be awarded to a professional, the placing will stand but the VHS qualification must be passed down to the highest placed amateur. This may happen retrospectively.
6. Spurs or spur bands may not be worn under any circumstances, including side saddle and foreign breed exhibits. This includes riding in before VH classes.
7. Showing canes/whips exceeding 76cm will not be permitted (except for side-saddle exhibits where SSA rules apply).

All horses competing in the ANCCE classes must arrive before 7pm on FRIDAY and may not leave until after the Special Awards on SUNDAY

ANCCE Morphology - Useful Information – Please read!

Mares do not have to do the Functionality Test, however if you do, then your mare's Functionality score is scored within its age group and is also eligible for the Special Award for Champion Functionality and the GB PRE Best Mare Functionality Award. Stallions 4 years old and over are scored 75% Morphology / 25% Functionality. It **IS NOT OBLIGATORY** for a stallion to complete a Functionality Test. However, a stallion **MUST** have completed a Functionality test to go through to the Special Awards for Champion Stallion. Despite this, a stallion that has **NOT** complete a Functionality test **IS** eligible for the Stallion Movement Special Award.

When entering please **Tick** the box if your horse is doing the Functionality test. The tests can be found on the Show Page on the GB PRE website – please make sure you download the correct test for your horses age group.


Horses 1 to 4 yrs old do not have to be graded, however 5+ years and must have been graded for this competition. Horses going to SICAB require to be graded at 4 yrs old to compete there.



The Masters Du Cheval Ibérique (MCI) is the only European dressage league and championship specifically for Iberian horses. This year the Europeans will be held on 23rd – 27th October in the Netherlands. A team to represent Great Britain will be selected based on qualifying scores on the league and the numbers of competitors that we are designated in each class/level.

The MCI GB is the official British Association for the MCI and completely independent of GB PRE. It includes qualifiers at dozens of independent venues across the country every year. It welcomes both purebred and partbred PREs (Pura Raza Española) and PSLs (Puro Sangue Lusitano) to compete in the series and at their UK Championship Event held every year, (2024 will be at Addington) although only purebred horses may qualify for the European Championship.


The MCI classes offer a variety of tests with young horse classes being the Primera and Novilla open to horses 4-6 years of age only. The Paso Doble (equivalent to preliminary level) and its freestyle to music partner test Salsa, and the Novato (equivalent to novice level) and its freestyle to music partner test Tango, are for horses aged 7 years and over. All other levels are open to any horse and rider combinations. English Riding Dress or Traditional Iberian Dress may be worn. Whips and callers are allowed at all MCI GB qualifiers in UK competitions.

All competitors are bound by the following rules and regulations whilst at the GB PRE National Championship Show 2024.

All specific Rules & Regulations for ALL classes can be found at www.gbpre.co.uk

General

1. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without specifying a reason.
2. No entry will be accepted without a signed acknowledgement of the Conditions of Entry and Safety Advice.
3. Any competitor/owner/handler using facilities not specified within the Showground shall be liable for all penalties incurred.
4. Show Organisers and GB PRE do not accept any liability for any accident, damage or injury to any horse, owner, rider, handler, spectator, or any other persons or property whatsoever.
5. At the discretion of the GB PRE Show Director - Entry fees will only be refunded on presentation of a veterinary certificate
6. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
7. Strictly NO SMOKING in any public areas.
9. For the safety of everyone, pedestrians, riders, handlers, etc. must obey all direction signs on the show ground.
10. Please be courteous at ALL TIMES to the Show Staff, Judges, and fellow competitors. Failure to do so may result in exclusion from the event and/or membership cancellation.
11. No Barbeques are allowed in the lorry park area.
12. No VEHICLES are permitted to enter the Stable Block Area.
13. Any complaint must be made in writing and within half an hour of the incident to the Show Director accompanied by £25
14. All ANCCE classes will run in accordance with ANCCE Rules & Regulations, published separately on the GB PRE website.
15. By entering the competition competitors agree to all Conditions of Entry.
16. It is strongly advised that exhibitors wear a correctly fitted riding hat when mounted, which has been manufactured to the current approved standard as outlined by the BHS and meets the appropriate affiliated societies rules and regulations. Hat standards can be found on these two links to the BHS.

Horses

1. All UK entries must be registered in the UK under correct ownership with BAPSH/ANCCE or their relevant breed society unless stated in the class description. Visiting horses from outside of the UK to compete in the ANCCE classes must be correctly registered with ANCCE via their relevant country. Invited breeds must be registered with their relevant breed society.
2. All horses must be accompanied by their passport, which must be available for inspection on arrival.
3. All Horses need to have had the primary & secondary as a minimum and not within 7 days of arrival. Annual vaccinations not within 7 days of arrival.
4. Horses present at the show must be in good health and body condition, and sound. If a horse is deemed to be unsuitable for competition by the Competition Vet or show committee the owner will be asked to withdraw the horse from the class. The decision of the Competition attending Vet is final.
5. All ridden horses must be 4yrs old and over.
6. Horses under inadequate control or whose riders/handlers cannot keep them in a manner acceptable to the judge /officials/other competitors will be asked to leave the ring at the judge's discretion and may also be asked to leave the showground.
7. All tack must be correctly fitted with extra care taken to young horses, colts and stallions.
8. Horses must be kept to a walk around the horsebox parking area, and around the stable area.
9. Horses must not be kept on lorries overnight
10. Horses must not be tied to the outside of a lorry.

Show Ring

1. The judge's decision is final. If any person wishes to lodge an objection, it must be made in writing to the Show Director within 30 minutes of the said incident, accompanied by £25.
2. The Organisers reserve the right to amend any details of times, rings, judges, including the cancellation, amalgamation or splitting of classes, where necessary.
3. In the event of a scheduled judge not being able to attend the Show, the entrants must accept the decisions of the judge deputised to act.
4. ANY act of discourtesy or disobedience to any judge or official on the part of an exhibitor, owner, groom, handler, or rider will, at the discretion of such official, disqualify the horse from being judged and may result in a request to leave the showground. All entry fees and charges will be forfeited.
5. Owners may be permitted, at their own discretion, to allow a foal to run free during the period that its dam is being judged, but at all other times all foals must remain on a lead line and halter.
6. No competitor or any assistant will be allowed into any show ring unless correctly attired. Judges or Ring Stewards may ask a competitor to change their attire if not correctly dressed for a class.

Transport

1. Horse Boxes & Trailers must be parked a minimum of 4 meters apart.
2. Lorries must carry a Fire Extinguisher in working order.
3. Cars must not be parked in the lorry park area. After unloading they must be moved to the car park.
4. No Vehicles are permitted to enter the Stable Block Area.
5. Barbeques are not allowed in the lorry park area
6. No mucking out into the lorry park: place all litter in the receptacles provided
7. Caravans will be parked in area the other side of the stream. There are hook ups adjacent to the Parkway Arena. No Caravans will be allowed in the Box Park.
8. Camping is not allowed around the arenas nor in the general car parks. The designated Camping area is behind the International Arena in the small paddock.
9. Stable deposits are ONLY refundable on show days.
10. Unreturned room keys are chargeable at £30 each.
11. The person to whom a room is allocated is responsible for the key.
