Important Entry Notes for Competitors

Please read these notes carefully before entering so that we can administer entries efficiently. If incorrect information is entered on the entry form, we will need to contact you to clarify the details.

Timeline

Before entering, please check the timeline to ensure that your classes do not clash. Once entries have closed on 30th June, we will adjust the timeline to reflect the final entry numbers and will issue an updated version.

Arrival, Stabling & Accommodation

Stable Managers Office Opening Times

Wednesday: 3:00pm – 7:30pm

Thursday: 9:00am – 7:30pm

Friday: 8:00am – 7:30pm

Saturday: 8:00am – 7:30pm

Sunday: 8:00am – Finish

Thursday - British Breeding futurity competitors may arrive from 10:30 am

Thursday - All other competitors may arrive from 12 noon.

If you plan to arrive after 7:30pm or before 7:00am, please contact Gemma or Kelly so the team can be informed.

All horses must report to the Stable Manager's Office with their passport before unloading. Kelly's office is in the hut as you enter the main Hartpury car park after the speed bumps. If you have booked accommodation, room keys can also be collected from the Stable Manager. Please note that any unreturned room keys will be charged at £40 by Hartpury.

Parking

- Only horseboxes and trailers staying overnight may park in the car park by the stable blocks.
- Day competitor horseboxes and trailers should park in the Overflow Car Park (signposted).
- All cars must park in the designated car park on the left-hand side of Hartpury Drive (signposted).

ANCCE Class Entries

When entering ANCCE classes:

- In the Owner box, please enter your ANCCE registered stud name, not your personal name.
- You will also need to include your ANCCE breeder or owner code.
- In the Notes section, please include:
 - The handler name for Morphology classes
 - The rider name for Functionality classes
 - The registration number required is the UELN number shown in the passport.
 - The horse must be registered with the correct owner.

All horses competing in ANCCE Morphology classes will be stabled in same-sex barns to assist with communication and organisation of classes.

All ANCCE Morphology horses must arrive by 7:00pm on Friday and may not leave until after the Special Awards on Sunday.

Notes for other classes

Horses entering Showing classes must be registered with a PIO, their relevant breed society or association and in the correct owner's name.

British Dressage

Please remember to enter:

- Whether you are competing at Bronze, Silver or Gold level
- Your British Dressage membership number

Stabling

Stables will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. All Working Equitation competitors will be stabled in the same barn. Hay and shavings will be available to purchase from the Stable Manager on site. Prices are listed in the schedule price list and are payable by card to the Stable Manager upon arrival. Please ensure that:

- The area around your stable is always kept tidy.
- Horses and competitors are respected by keeping noise levels down at night.
- Your contact details are placed on your stable door in case of emergency.

Stable Deposit Refunds will be made only during the show £10 cash. We will not be issuing any refunds after the event.

Stable deposits will not be refunded if the stable is not left:

- With all wet bedding and droppings removed
- With clean shavings banked around the edges
- Swept clean





Rules, Regulations & Conditions of Entry **GB PRE 2026**



General

1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without specifying a reason.
2. No entry will be accepted without acknowledgement of the Conditions of Entry and Safety Advice.
3. Any competitor, owner or handler using facilities not specified within the showground will be liable for any penalties incurred.
4. Show organisers and GB PRE accept no liability for any accident, damage or injury to any horse, owner, rider, handler, spectator, or property.
5. All dogs must be always kept on a lead.
6. Strictly no smoking in public areas.
7. All pedestrians, riders and handlers must obey showground signage and directions.
8. Please always be courteous to show staff, judges and fellow competitors. Failure to do so may result in exclusion from the event and/or membership cancellation.
9. Barbecues are not permitted in the lorry park area.
10. No vehicles are permitted in the stable block area.
11. Complaints must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a £25 fee (non-refundable).
12. ANCCE classes will run in accordance with ANCCE Rules & Regulations, published separately on the GB PRE website.
13. By entering the competition, competitors agree to all Conditions of Entry.
14. Refunds: All refunds are made at the discretion of the Organisers. Where a refund is agreed, it will be issued less any non-refundable payment processing fees (including Stripe & Equipe fees) and will be subject to a £20 administration charge.
15. Entry fees will only be refunded at the discretion of the Show Director, upon presentation of a valid veterinary certificate and are subject to point number 14 regarding refunds.

Safety – Riding Hats

All riders must wear a correctly fitted riding hat manufactured to the current approved BHS safety standards and compliant with the rules of the relevant affiliated society.

Approved hat standards can be found on the GB PRE website under the GB PRE Show tab.

Any rider choosing not to follow this recommendation does so entirely at their own risk.

Riders competing in parade/traditional tack & dress classes who choose not to wear a BHS-approved hat do so entirely at their own risk..

Amateur & Professional Definitions

Amateur:

A person who participates in the sport for pleasure rather than financial benefit and does not compete for payment.

Professional:

A person whose primary income is derived from the production, training, exhibition or sale of competition horses.

Horses

1. UK entries must be registered under correct ownership with ANCCE, BAPSH, a UK PIO, or the relevant breed society, unless otherwise stated.
2. Visiting horses must be correctly registered with ANCCE via their country of origin.
3. Horses must be accompanied by their passport, available for inspection upon arrival.
4. Horses must have received primary and booster vaccinations, not within 7 days of arrival.
5. Horses must be in good health, sound and in appropriate body condition.
6. The attending veterinary's decision is final
7. All ridden horses must be 4 years old or older.
8. Horses not under adequate control may be asked to leave the ring or the showground.
9. Tack must be correctly fitted, particularly for young horses, colts and stallions.
10. Horses must be kept at a walk around stable and parking areas.
11. Horses must not be kept on lorries overnight.
12. Horses must not be tied to the outside of lorries.
13. Horses may compete in a maximum of 4 classes per day.

FEI Prohibited Substances

14. All horses competing at GB PRE must comply with the FEI Equine Prohibited Substances List (EPLS) 2026. The use of any substance listed on the FEI Equine Prohibited Substances List is strictly prohibited. Competitors are responsible for ensuring that their horses are free from any prohibited substances at the time of competition.
15. GB PRE reserves the right to take appropriate action should any breach of these regulations be suspected.

Show Ring

1. The judge's decision is final. If any person wishes to lodge an objection, it must be made in writing to the Show Director within 30 minutes of the said incident, accompanied by £25 (Non-refundable)
2. The Organisers reserve the right to amend any details of times, rings, judges, including the cancellation, amalgamation or splitting of classes, where necessary.
3. In the event of a scheduled judge not being able to attend the Show, the entrants must accept the decisions of the judge deputised to act.
4. ANY act of discourtesy or disobedience to any judge or official on the part of an exhibitor, owner, groom, handler, or rider will, at the discretion of such official, disqualify the horse from being judged and may result in a request to leave the showground. All entry fees and charges will be forfeited.
5. Owners may be permitted, at their own discretion, to allow a foal to run free during the period that its dam is being judged, but at all other times all foals must remain on a lead line and halter.
6. No competitor or any assistant will be allowed into any show ring unless correctly attired. Judges or Ring Stewards may ask a competitor to change their attire if not correctly dressed for a class.
7. Only the Official Show Photographer has authorized access within any ring/arena of the competition.

ALL HORSES MUST REPORT TO THE STABLE MANAGERS OFFICE ON ARRIVAL



Transport

1. Horse Boxes & Trailers must be parked a minimum of 4 meters apart.
2. All lorries, 3.5tn and over, must carry a fire extinguisher in working order.
3. Cars must not be parked in the lorry park area. After unloading they must be moved to the car park.
4. No Vehicles are permitted to enter the Stable Block Area.
5. Barbecues are not allowed in the lorry park area
6. No mucking out into the lorry park: place all litter in the receptacles provided
7. Caravans will be parked in area the other side of the stream. There are hook ups adjacent to the Parkway Arena. No Caravans will be allowed in the Box Park.
8. Camping is not allowed around the arenas nor in the general car parks. The designated Camping area is behind the International Arena in the small paddock.
9. Stable deposits are ONLY refundable on show days.
10. Unreturned room keys are chargeable at £40 each.
11. The person to whom a room is allocated is responsible for the key.
