



## DOMA VAQUERA (COUNTRY STYLE)

### RIDER

Sombrero, with or without chinstrap

Campo jacket, top button only fastened

Matching waistcoat preferred

Plain white shirt, buttoned

No gloves

Trousers with turnups (worn with long boots) OR

Trousers with cairelles (worn with short boots and half chaps)

Scarf tied around waist (colours sympathetic with overall colourway)

Zahones (full chaps) optional

Spurs optional (brown straps preferred unless in Doma Vaquera competition)

*Clothing colours should not be restricted for a Parade or Feria. If competing in a strict Tack & Dress scenario, then muted or earth colours preferred.*

### TACK

Vaquero saddle, either standard or mixta (with gallery to front)

Wool Scarf tied to the front of the saddle

No saddle cloth

Triangular iron or plastic stirrups

Crupper (colour to match girth and stirrup leathers)

Single Bridle. With or without throatlatch. Leather fronds or horsehair mosquero permitted.

Vaquero bit (straight or ported bar. Reins preferred on the curb only. It is acceptable for younger or novice horses to have a second set of reins on the bit to allow a Pelham style action.

*NB. Doma Vaquera is intended to be shown single handed.*

**Breastgirth optional**

**No bandages**

**No boots**

## ALTA ESCUELA (HIGH SCHOOL STYLE)

### RIDER

Black hat

Matching Jacket and waistcoat

White shirt, buttoned

Cravat style neck tie, tied in a bow. Often peach/pink, but colours optional

Light tan gloves

Pantalon style trousers, worn with white over-the-knee stockings

Short boots with half chaps

Spurs optional (brown straps)

### TACK

Alta Escuela or Espanola Saddle. Preferred without sheepskin. Grey preferred

No saddle cloth

Iron Gomez stirrups

Crupper (colour to match girth and stirrup leathers)

Double Bridle. With or without throatlatch. Horsehair or silk mosquero.

Black double bit set preferred. "S" shaped Real Escuela bits permitted, also "scallop edged vaquero pattern.

**Breastgirth optional**

**No bandages**

**No boots**

## HORSE & DISPLAY

### HORSE

Manes either double or running plait preferred. Loose acceptable.

**Tails tied up or loose for Doma Vaquera.**

**Loose for Alta Escuela.**

### DISPLAYING THE HORSE

Horses are to "Parade" around the ring together in one direction.

Individuals may display in the centre of the ring, being mindful of other participants, and keeping a safe distance from the Judges.

High School movements are permitted, however, the rider must remain mounted at all times.

**There will be no individual show required.**
